

QHSE (QUALITY, HEALTH, SAFETY AND ENVIRONMENTAL) POLICY

- assessment of all identified risks to our ships, personnel and environment and establishing appropriate safeguards to manage these risks
- continuous improvement of safety management skills of personnel ashore and aboard ships, including preparing for emergencies related both to safety and environmental protection
- compliance with applicable legal requirements, and with other requirements to which CMS is subscribed, and its environmental aspects

Our company is committed to enhance Customer requirements and continually improve effectiveness of the Fully Integrated SEQMS (Safety, Environment & Quality Management System), and we will encourage active participation and contribution of inputs from our personnel to achieve this. Our SEQMS has been designed to meet the requirements of;

- Quality Standard ISO 9001:2008
- Occupational Health & Safety Standard OHSAS 18001:2007
- IMO's ISM Code 2010 for the Safe Operation of Vessels
- Pollution Prevention and Environmental Standard ISO 14001:2004.

We will comply with local and international legislation which we have subscribed to, and we will review our compliance with this legislation at regular intervals not exceeding 12 calendar months.

Company Management will monitor, measure and analyse organizational goals and expectations to verify that the processes are implemented effectively. Company SEQMS will allow normal business decision making processes to control and monitor risks and verify adherence to performance standards.
